A three-session program designed for parents, grandparents and other relative caregivers who are in a parenting role.

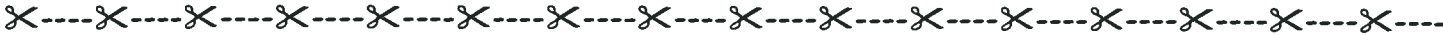

Light refreshments will be served to program participants.

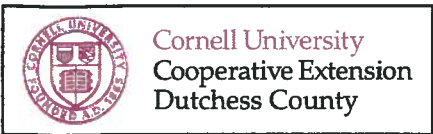
