

Celebrate Grandparents' Day Sunday, September 12, 2010



The first people to advocate for Grandparents' Day were Hermine Beckett Hanna and Marian McQuade who, independently of one another, petitioned Congress and the American people, to recognize the strengths and achievements of older Americans. In 1973 Senator Jennings Randolph introduced legislation that would recognize the first Sunday after Labor Day, as National Grandparents Day. Five years later, President Jimmy Carter signed a proclamation:

“... to honor grandparents, to give grandparents an opportunity to show love for their children's children, and to help children become aware of strength, information, and guidance older people can offer”.
