

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Kinship Caregiver Program

The Liberty Resources Kinship Caregiver program provides a continuum of services to families in Oswego or Onondaga County who are providing full-time care on a formal or informal basis for youth with whom they have a connection by blood or prior relationship.

Program Goal: To provide a level of care and support that will assist the non-parent caregivers in providing a safe and nurturing environment in which youth can thrive.

Target Population: The Kinship Caregiver Program is designed to serve any Oswego or Onondaga County family providing full-time care to a youth not born to them.

Program Design

The Kinship Caregiver Program offers an array of services tailored to meet the needs and build on the strengths of the individual family.

For many families, referral and linkage to available resources that offer supports such as financial, educational or legal information and community programs will be sufficient.

Other families may take advantage of the program's case management or the availability of small financial grants for specific needs.

Intensive case management support is provided by a Master's level clinical social worker.

Referral Procedure

Referral is simple. A kinship family may call to request any of the available services. Referrals are also accepted from any private or public community agency or organization.
